Making Effective Decisions and Leading Change (December 1): Decision opportunities and the use of a four-phase model of organizational change will equip you with the skills to handle changes in your organization.

Managing Human Relations (January 19): Successful engagement in the hiring process as well as overcoming performance problems are needed to make sure employees are working to their full capabilities.

Getting the Best Out of Your Employees (February 16): Assuring that your employees are motivated, setting goals and receiving feedback is critical for those in a leadership position.

Enabling Successful Strategies (March 16): Learn how to craft the right strategy and then execute this strategy through managing and tracking organization initiatives.
