St. Peter’s Health Partners celebrated the completion of its \$105 million Troy Master Facilities Plan and held a grand opening for the Heinrich Medicus Pavilion at Samaritan Hospital. With its new, state-of-the-art emergency department, intensive care unit, progressive care unit, medical/surgical units and endoscopy suite, the five-story patient pavilion is the centerpiece of the Troy Master Plan. 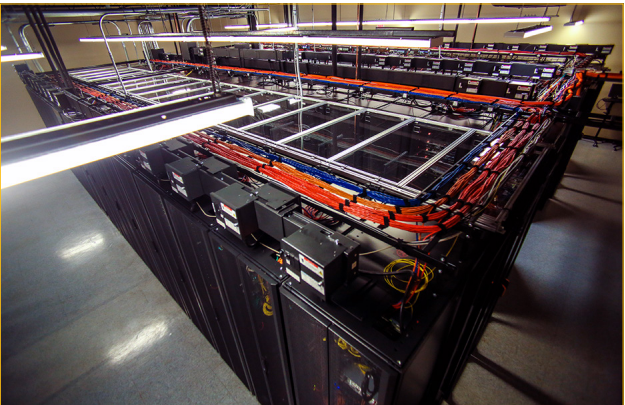
